Safe HelpRoom is a group chat service that allows survivors of sexual assault in the military to connect with and support one another in a moderated and secure online environment.

- ✓ Survivors can access Safe HelpRoom at safehelproom.org
- ✓ Available 24/7
- ✓ Safe Helpline staff members moderate sessions, ensuring adherence to Ground Rules to protect the anonymity and safety of participants, providing referrals, and focusing conversation on survivor needs

Men's Safe HelpRoom

Men's Safe HelpRoom sessions provide a space where male survivors of sexual assault can connect with one another to provide and receive support.

- Sessions are on **Sundays from 1pm to 3pm ET** and accessible at safehelproom.org
- These sessions are **an additional opportunity** for men to be able to explore their experiences
